Did you know?

- ◆ The outcome of soft tissue sarcomas depends upon the stage of cancer and time of diagnosis.
- ◆ If detected at an early stage, it can be removed during surgery and possibly can be cured.
- ◆ Regular check-ups are needed after treatment to see if any signs of cancer have come back.
- ◆ Long term physiotherapy and occupational therapy can support patient outcome.
- ◆ The survival rate for those diagnosed with a soft tissue sarcoma is at least five years from the point of its detection.
